## A BILL

To temporarily increase the borrowing authority of the Federal Emergency Management Agency for carrying out the national flood insurance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Flood Insur-  
5 ance Program Further Enhanced Borrowing Authority  
6 Act of 2005”.

7 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN BORROWING AUTHORITY.**

8 The first sentence of subsection (a) of section 1309  
9 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.  
10 4016(a)), as amended by the National Flood Insurance



1 Program Enhanced Borrowing Authority Act of 2005  
2 (Public Law 109–65; 119 Stat. 1998), is amended by  
3 striking “\$3,500,000,000” and inserting  
4 “\$8,500,000,000”.
